

RESOLUTION for approval of MP committees planning model

WHEREAS the work on restoration and preserving the public's beneficial uses of Lake Merced still has not been completed, and

WHEREAS much work done by the City and its agencies in the past at Lake Merced often fails to fit into any coherent, long-term plan for improvement of the lake, and

WHEREAS the lack of a comprehensive Master Plan is a significant obstacle to improve conditions at Lake Merced, in particular its natural and recreational uses, and

WHEREAS the City and its agencies responsible for for Lake Merced are supportive of a Master Plan, they are unable, because of current dire financial and budgetary reasons, to assist with producing a Master Plan, and

WHEREAS it is certain that if the LMTF does not undertake the urgent, important task of insisting that a Master Plan be developed, it equally certain that it may be years, if ever, before a Master Plan is finally completed,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the LMTF approves the Final Report of the LMTF Ad Hoc Master Plan Committee as an appropriate model for the planning of future restoration and improvement of the beneficial uses of Lake Merced.
