

Resolution for World Environmental Day 2005

WHEREAS the United Nations has selected the City of San Francisco to host the World Environmental Day 2005 (WED2005) this June; and

WHEREAS the UN WED2005 will bring the mayors of the world's 100 most populous cities including numerous other dignitaries and officials from around the world to this week-long event; and

WHEREAS the overall theme of WED2005 is "Green Cities" including open space, biodiversity, and greening the urban environment; and

WHEREAS the WED2005 event would be an excellent opportunity to showcase Lake Merced and its unique features as an urban natural resource; and

WHEREAS it is in the long-term interests of both San Francisco and Lake Merced that the lake is promoted as much for what it could be as for what it is;

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the LMTF authorizes its Steering Committee to determine the feasibility and logistics of hosting a Lake Merced event as part of the larger WED2005.
